**Report on current progress with SIP**

We are still on track for the activities and the data of the SIP.  
Dibels report came back and it showed majority had growth. Those that didn't we are working with those teachers to help them and their students succeed.  
Math is still being tested. We won't know those scores until possibly April.  
CRT: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Full Interim testing or benchmarks: 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>

**Feedback from Teachers (Jennie, Lori and Jennifer)**

Most teachers would like to see a Math, LA and an attendance goal.

Aides: Every grade level wants the math lab managers. Half of the grades want to keep the classroom tutors (Land Trust and Title 1). We have 7 aides currently. School staff would like to keep those aides, but have flexibility in how and when they are used.

Some of the teachers would like us to have a side that fills in as an aide, but also can be used as a sub if she/he is needed somewhere in the school.

If we keep the same number of aides, it will be about \$47,000.

Every grade level has different needs and would like money to get more supplies, offer better learning opportunities to the students, and get updated technology.

Funding for 2018-2019: \$70,737 and with the current carry over, we'll have \$76,737.

The refresh money that we get every year has been directed by the district to be used to buy a certain number electronic items to be used to increase the one on one initiative.

After we take out what we need for the goals, aides, etc. it was suggested that we use the remainder to help reach the 1:1 initiative with technology. There is also a possibility that we will have another \$10,000 to add to this once Logan Toone double checks the budget from this year.

So we need to decide how to allocate the \$30,000 left between grade level needs for SIP goals and technology.

Discussion of grants and donations for covering teacher requests. Cassidy and Liz were going to see if they can get Cassidy's brother-in-law to teach us how to write them.
