- 1. <u>Call to Order</u> Kim Shepardson Watson called the meeting to order at 6:18 p.m.

They stated that we need to move forward with the plan as a postponement could have huge financial consequences. They discussed renovation vs. new construction and explained why a renovation can be more costly. Portia Bordelon stated that she hopes any plan will include an investigation of the lead pipes.
