We received the Sage testing results for our school. School are evaluated on growth and proficiency. We received a Gold Recognition Star recognition for growth. We improved significantly from last year. We should have a future agenda items to thoroughly review those results.

Dress Code Follow Up

Building Temperature Plan:

Another problem is that we are a testing site for AP. Testing in May is very critical to have an environment conducive to doing well. Excessive temperatures affect how students perform.

The \$107,000 we received comes from the Trustland. Watched two videos educating the council about what the Trustland is and does. We have a School LAND and Trust Plan on how Syracuse Junior High has and will allocate the funds.

Davis School District combines the School Improvement Plan and the Trustland Plan. SNAP. Safe Neighborhood Access Plan.

2017-2018 Trustland Budget Overview:

- 1. The budget from last year is in the minutes from the April 2017 Community Council meeting. We are not discussing how to use to funds but how we are in the process of using these funds.
- 2. Special Education amount was approved but not funded. We just received the grant that will make it possible to receive those funds.
- 3. Principal Hadlock feels confident that the actual amount that we will be able to use will be in excess of \$109,000.
- 4. School Improvement Plan is found under the Community Council link under important information.
- 5. We will meet as a Community Council to discuss the budget for next year prior to March 14th.
- 6. We should have a report from the individual departments to report on the progress on how the funds are being used.

We would like to do a parent night QPR training. This is a training for parents on how to recognize and prevent suicide, and we would like to work with the Hope Squad to do the training. We would like to schedule a training for parents in October and in the spring.
