Information literacy is the ability to identify, find, evaluate, and use information effectively. Evaluating the quality and credibility of a source and giving it credit are information literacy skills.

Start thinking about how you find information online and what you do with that information. Are you using good online searching strategies to efficiently get to credible information? Are you careful to always give your sources credit? Use these next few weeks to evaluate your information literacy.
