

Requirements for N.H.S. Membership Consideration 2018

Membership in the National Honor Society is based on excellence in four areas: Scholarship, Leadership, Service, and Character. Once a student has met the grade point average requirement to qualify scholastically as a candidate, he/she must also qualify in the other areas listed above. Further, if selected, the student must maintain a minimum grade point average of at least 3.500 and uphold and encourage the character, leadership, and service ideals of the National Honor Society. Finally, all candidates are required to fulfill all society commitments and obligations.

Scholarship: All students with a GPA of 3.500 or above are considered eligible for further consideration in the areas of leadership, service, and character.

Leadership, Service, and Character: The chapter adviser must receive the following items by the date and time listed below. **Incomplete, inaccurate, or late submissions may disqualify a candidate from consideration. Forms must be filled out in ink or typed. Please organize paperwork in order and submit your paperwork in a folder labeled with your name on the outside.**

1. **Your Check List-** signed and completed.
2. **Two Recommendation Forms** filled out by I.H.S. teachers who know you well. **These forms should be given to your teachers at least one week before they are due. They are returned directly to Mrs. Pinckney by the teacher.**
3. **The Student Activity Information Packet**, truthfully and completely filled out, including adults' signatures* and telephone numbers. Activities should be listed without unnecessary repetition. Write "None" or "Unsure" when appropriate.
4. **At least one Leadership Form**, truthfully and completely filled out and signed*. **Remember:** your leadership essay must **explain specifically** how you've demonstrated leadership **among your peers or with adults.**
5. **Service Project** form, truthfully and completely filled out, and essay.
6. **One Personal Statement** form, truthfully and completely filled out, and essay.
7. **One letter from an adult other than a relative attesting to your character in relation to a specific activity of which the adult has personal knowledge. This letter must be signed by the adult and submitted with the candidate's packet in a sealed envelope.**
8. **Member Obligations and Information Forms** completed and signed by the candidate and his/her parent or guardian.

There will be an **optional meeting on Thursday, September 27th** at 2:05 in Room 303 to answer candidates' questions.

***Adult signatures must be the most appropriate to the activity and written on the appropriate form and/or on the essay you compose.**
