STEM Engineering Challenges

(Grades 3 & 4)

Strange Changes

(Kindergarten-Grade 1)

Can we make silly putty, playdough or use vegetables to test foods for acidity using common materials found in most households? In this class, the participants will practice “kitchen chemistry” to learn about chemical and physical changes.

It Flew Through the Air Mr. Wollney (Grades 2-4)

From gliders to missiles, participants will build and fly or shoot various devices that create projectile motion. Newton’s laws and principles of construction will play a large part in this course. Catapults, kites and water bottle rockets are some of the projects that can be expected.



Alternative Energy Mr. Wollney (Grades 4 and 5)

Participants will learn about alternatives to fossil fuels by building devices that utilize solar energy, wind, water power and biomass energy. To assess and compare the efficiency of the devices, they will be designed to accomplish work by lifting a standard mass to a height of one meter. Water wheels, wind mills and solar cars are a few of the projects that will be constructed in this course.

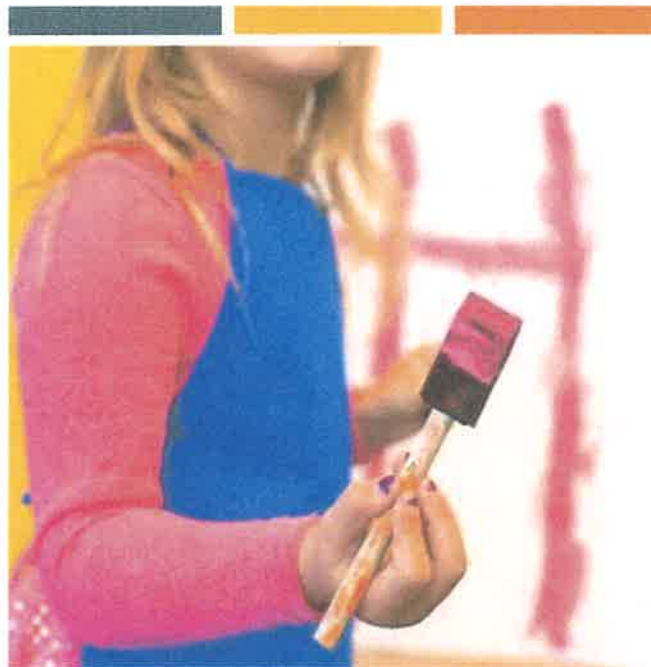


Cupcake Battle Adventure
