We have assessed our readers' progress with Istation assessments. The Istation Indicators of Progress (ISIP) measures student growth per requirements of the State Department of Education and the Idaho Reading Indicator. You will see an overall score and also strength and growth areas identified.

ISIP Early Reading is a computer-adaptive assessment. Your child receives questions based on his or her individual ability. Every question presented is based on the response to the previous question. These assessments immediately deliver reports to our instructional staff about your child's reading progress. With the information from these reports, your child will receive individualized instruction as necessary to target those areas needing improvement.
