

## Wechsler Intelligence Scales (WPPSI-IV, WISC-V) Guidelines for Submission

All Nueva applicants for grades PreK–8 are required to submit the results of a Wechsler IQ evaluation, along with an authorized release form from a licensed clinical psychologist. The following guidelines are for families who make an appointment for IQ testing with a psychologist off-campus. Please review them carefully, and then share them with the psychologist you have chosen.

**Off-campus WISC test results are due January 25, 2019 and off-campus WPPSI test results are due February 8, 2019.**

NOTE: The Nueva application is due Thursday, January 10, 2019.

**Any licensed clinical psychologist who is experienced in administering the Wechsler Scales to children can administer the evaluation.** Please check local listings for referrals.

**The Wechsler Scales should be given in a school or office setting.**

**Nueva accepts the results of the WPPSI-IV or WISC-V.** Applicants must be 3 years 10 months or older for the WPPSI-IV. Applicants who are 6 years of age and older must take the WISC-V.

**The following subtests are required for our application process for the WPPSI-IV and the WISC-V:**

- **WPPSI-IV:** Block Design, Information, Matrix Reasoning, Bug Search, Picture Memory, Similarities, Picture Concepts, and Cancellation.
- **WISC-V:** Block Design, Similarities, Matrix Reasoning, Digit Span, Coding, Vocabulary, Figure Weights, Visual Puzzles, Picture Span, Symbol Search, and Arithmetic.

We require a Full Scale IQ (FSIQ) to be reported.

**Prior exposure to test materials invalidate results.** Please be aware your child should not study for the evaluation. The tests are designed to capture current cognitive abilities.

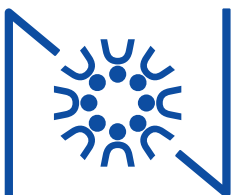
**Applicants may only take the Wechsler Scales once in 12 months.**

**If the results are more than 2 years old, or have been provided for two admissions cycles, the applicant will need to take the evaluation again.**

**A narrative report with behavioral observations must accompany the scores.**

**The psychologist needs your signed permission to release the results to Nueva, which can be done by mail or email.** Release forms can be found on our website: [www.nuevaschool.org/admissions/iq-faq](http://www.nuevaschool.org/admissions/iq-faq).

**After the psychologist has submitted the test results and narrative, we will follow up with you regarding next steps in the application process.**

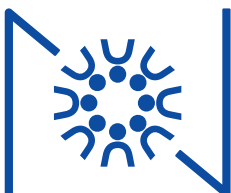
