CNN Newscast

Are you interested in learning how to create videos? Do you want to be a part of the announcements? Are you motivated and a self-starter? Come and learn how to make a really great newscast for the daily school announcements.

Current Events/Debate

Do you want a space to create with technology, duct tape, cardboard, found objects, and much more? Then this CESIT is for you. We will use technology including ozobots, sphero, and 3d pens. We will also create fun projects with everyday objects. Join us for a creative start to your morning.

Monopoly

Let's get together and play the well-known game that involves both the process of buying land for its development, and also the sale of any undeveloped property. It was also created as a tool to explain the single tax theory and illustrate the negative aspects of concentrating land in private monopolies.

Movies, Media and the World

In this Cesit we will examine the role of movies/media in culture. We will watch a variety of productions and discuss the implications these pieces have had on our culture and the world at large. Students will be asked to discuss their understanding and engage in academic conversation about what we view.

Origami for Fun

Learn how origami is used in the auto industry, space devices, along with many other aspects of our everyday life while transforming a piece of paper into a work of art! We will learn the basic origami folds to create a paper crane or 4-pointed star and then combine the folds in a variety of ways to make more intricate designs.

Penmanship

You will learn the endangered art of cursive handwriting, but more importantly, your handwriting will improve in general as your control of the pen becomes more disciplined. This course is for *anyone* who wants to improve their handwriting!

Pottery

We will begin with basic properties of clay, techniques to teach you skills to use on more advanced projects. Some of the projects we will do include: Alien planters, wide mouthed fish candy dish, animal masks and hand built vases. This is such an enjoyable class, who doesn't love clay?

Robotics

Robotics is an opportunity to explore the science and technology of robotics. Students will build and program NXT and EV3 robots. No experience is required.
