ACADEMIC OPPORTUNITIES

Murphy Scholars Program: High-performing students pursue a demanding course of study supported through cultural enrichment experiences and co-curricular participation.

Experiential Engineering Education Program (E3): Three-year track to intellectually engage and challenge students with a rigorous engineering-focused curriculum.

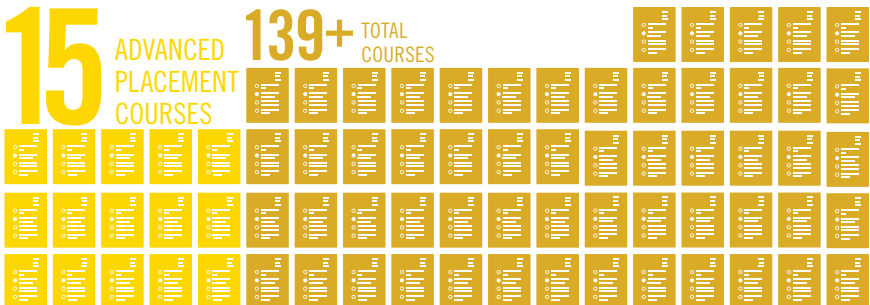
Arts: When many schools are making cuts to fine and performing arts programs, Totino-Grace students have access through coursework and co-curricular experiences.



COLLEGE & CAREER PLANNING

Totino-Grace has a robust college counseling program. Our licensed school counselors and dedicated college and career planning director provide students and parents personalized service through a four-year college planning process. In addition to events, training, workshops, and courses, counselors advocate for our students with college admission offices and help them seek out scholarship opportunities. The recommended national ratio of school counselors to students is 250:1. Totino-Grace boasts an average of 228:1, which is dramatically better than the Minnesota average of 743:1.

A FOCUS ON SERVICE

Service hours are not required at Totino-Grace yet 16,300 volunteer and mission trip hours are amassed annually by nearly half of the student body. This number translates to 22 hours per student on average.

The foundation of our educational experience is our core values of learning, faith, service, and community. Our Catholic Lasallian mission is centered on the message of Jesus Christ and animated through the tradition of our founding orders, the Christian Brothers and School Sisters of Notre Dame.

As a comprehensive college-preparatory school, we know that not all students are on an accelerated academic track. Our Learning Lab offers programming and personal attention to students in need of individual academic support.

FACULTY & STAFF

Totino-Grace faculty members pursue advanced degrees, certification, and training as a commitment to their vocation and our students. More than 1/3 of our teachers have been with the school longer than 20 years and nearly three dozen serve as coaches and moderators.

Totino-Grace takes pride maintaining a community that is small enough to know students on a personal level but large enough to serve student interest and participation outside of the classroom through sports and activities.

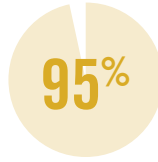

COLLEGE MATRICULATION STATISTICS



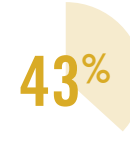
MATRICULATING TO COLLEGE OUT OF 173 GRADUATES

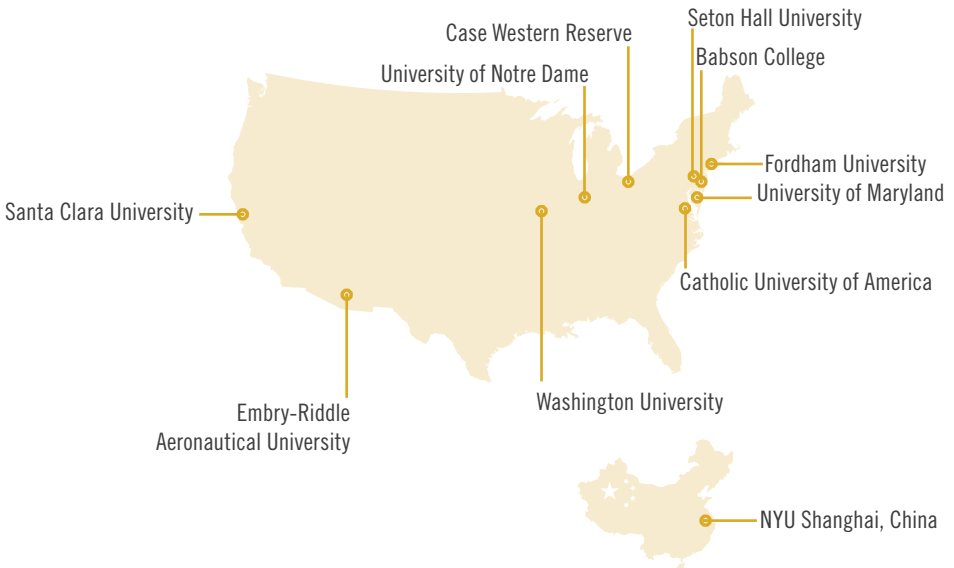
