


Read, Rise, and Fly – A Conversation with Andrew Crawford

Artist and Alumni Parent

Q. When did you become interested in ironwork?

A. I started working with metal when I was at the Rhode Island School of Design. I was immediately drawn to the material for its versatility, durability, and integrity. I found as a metal worker, I could apply my skills and craft to a commercially applicable trade.

Q. Why did you decide to create the Phoenix?

A. I created the Phoenix because it is a far greater gift to the School than I could give financially. The Phoenix sculpture represents creativity, individuality, and the result of pursuing one's true interest and passion.

Q. What are your largest and smallest works?

A. I have created works of all sizes - a monumental sculpture at the Federal Reserve Bank in Atlanta, a fifty-foot entrance gate at the Atlanta Botanical Garden, silver jewelry inspired by garden gates, and thousands of sculptures, fixtures, and furnishings all over the country and world.

Q. Where can we see more of your work?

A. I have work in most of the fifty states. More remote locations include a garden gate for a country estate outside of London, shelves, lights, and racks for a bar on Midway Island in the Pacific Ocean, and a metal lobster attached to a coral reef island on the Island of Utila off the coast of Honduras.

Around the state, my work can be seen at the Atlanta Botanical Garden, the State Botanical Garden in Athens, Holy Innocents' Episcopal Church, the Paidea School, Springmont, Brenau University in Gainesville, and hundreds of private homes and gardens around town. And, of course, now the Phoenix is outside of the front office at The Schenck School!





Andrew Crawford is a practicing sculptor who works in metal, wood, and found objects. His parents, who set up a workshop for him in their home, encouraged his early artistic endeavors in clay, drawing, music, and sculpture. Andrew is also an alumni parent. His daughter, Tuesday, outplaced in 2017 and now attends The Children's School. Andrew T. Crawford Ironworks is in northeast Atlanta.

The Cheryl Mullins Nature Walk Revealed!

This became known as the "Infinity Project."

The Infinity Project invites essays from the public explaining why they would like to participate. Sarah, unbeknownst to anyone, wrote an essay which included her work with dyslexic students at The Schenck School.

Well, it turns out that Josh Simpson is dyslexic! He thought The Schenck School was the perfect candidate to be part of the project. He sent Sarah two glass planet marbles, one to bury and one to keep.

Hold this thought.

Chapter 2: Principal Cheryl Mullins retired from The Schenck School in 2016, and, because of her love of nature, she was presented with the gift of the Cheryl Mullins Nature Walk, soon to be created.

Alumni parent Jack Weeks walked the perimeter of the School with several staff members and helped identify specific trees, plants, and other natural spots of interest.

The draft of the proposed Walk was conceived and drawn into a plan. Then, we tried to work out how to implement the wonderful plan.

Chapter 3: Schenck School alumnus Ronan Lehane, then a junior at The Galloway School, was an Eagle Scout candidate and needed a project in order to complete the rank. He contacted the School to see if there was anything he could do to help us. Aha!!!

Ronan readily agreed to install the path. Additionally, he floated the idea of making several Peace Poles to place along the path. Art teacher Steve Shaw agreed to lead the creative process and produced five dyslexia-related Peace Poles.

Final chapter: On May 2, 2018, faculty, staff, Ronan, and his parents joined Cheryl to formally reveal the walk. Along with several other gifts, the second glass planet was presented to Cheryl, and Ronan revealed where he buried the first one.

We are sincerely appreciative of the visionary leaders, gifted educators, and dedicated families whose gifts have ensured that The Schenck School will continue to change the lives of dyslexic learners now and in the future.

Janet Martin Scholarship Fund: Janet and Martin Schenck were David Schenck's aunt and uncle. A letter dated May 10, 1966 (seven years after David and Dee founded the School), states: "It gives me great pleasure to send you the enclosed check to use in any way you

and the Trustees wish for The Schenck School. Not only am I interested because of my regard for you but because, as somewhat of an educator, I am concerned that experimental schools going into new fields such as this one should have an opportunity to make their great contribution." With this in mind, the Board of Trustees chose to establish a financial aid endowment.

Nan T. Schenck Endowment: The fund was established in 1982 and named for David Schenck's mother. The family's intent was to establish a general endowment to ensure the continued success and financial stability of the School. In 2017, a substantial sum from the will of Emeritus Trustee William "Bill" C. Hatcher was added to this endowment.

The Shults Family Endowed Fund for Financial Aid: The fund was established in 2017 by gifts from the Shults and Julian families to ensure that financial need will not be a barrier to attending The Schenck School.

Sebastian Montana ('17)

My name is Sebastian Montana. I am 12 years old, and I am proud to be dyslexic. I was diagnosed with dyslexia at the end of kindergarten, but my parents didn't tell me I was dyslexic until I was in the second grade. I didn't know what dyslexia meant, but I knew it had to be something that made me different. I felt dumb and was always embarrassed because I didn't know how to read. It was hard leaving the School that I had just loved way too much. It was hard to leave the place that changed me forever.





The Dyslexia Resource, a nonprofit organization founded by the Schenck School Board of Trustees in 2014, is a community resource that helps students overcome reading deficiencies through research, partnerships, education, and outreach programs.



We thank our donors for enabling The Dyslexia Resource to:

- Expand partnerships to include Purpose Built Schools Atlanta (PBSA) beginning at their Thomasville Heights Elementary School site and also at Westside Atlanta Charter School to implement The Schenck School Reading Model through all levels of literacy instruction and provide direct, small-group intervention to over 750 students during a three-year period.
- Partner with Purpose Built School Atlanta's T. H. Slater Elementary School to collect performance data to develop a student services program for the 2019-2020 academic year.
