DECEMBER CONCERTS AND BOOK FAIR

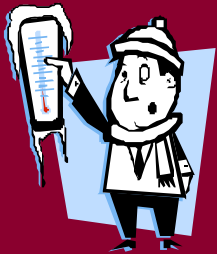
