



Get High School Credit for What You Already Know!

Are you bi-lingual or did you learn a foreign language on your own? Do you have outstanding Computer Literacy skills? Do you know all about how government works? Davis School District now offers students the opportunity to “test out” and receive credit for subjects they may have learned outside of school. If you pass the test, you will receive a P (Pass) for that course and receive the appropriate number of credits. It is important to know that these classes **DO NOT COUNT** toward NCAA credit requirements, and may not count for the Regents’ Scholarship. Here is the information from Northern Utah Regional Testing Center at the Davis School District Headquarters. **Please note that you must be recommended by your counselor or an administrator to take the tests.** We strongly encourage you to talk with your counselor to ensure you retain eligibility for special programs such as NCAA and Regents’ Scholarship.
