When Should A Child Stay Home?

If a child is vomiting or has diarrhea, he/she should stay home for 24 hours after the vomiting or diarrhea has stopped. If a child has a temperature of 100 degrees or greater, he/she should remain at home. Students should remain at home for 24 hours without fever reducing medication, such as Tylenol, before returning to school. Schools are not properly staffed or equipped to tend to the clinical needs of sick children. Our school can only temporarily provide for your child's medical needs if they are ill. Parents should arrive promptly following a phone call from school.
