SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Dr. Beresford reported that the first round of new teacher orientations occurred on July 18. He was impressed with the quality and diverse amount of experience these educators will bring to Carmel Clay Schools.
- Dr. Beresford shared that the CCS energy management program saved \$1,044,611 for the 2017-18 school year. Since 1995, the district has saved \$21,185,436 million dollars through this program.
- Dr. Beresford reported that he has met several times with School Resource Officer Sergeant D. J. Schoeff to review and evaluate the current safety and security layers in the district. He shared that the district is researching two-way communication systems.
- Dr. Beresford reported that the Director of Student Service position for the district has been posted. A major component of this position will be managing the district's school safety program. There are currently more than 60 applicants and the district looks forward to hiring a highly qualified individual for this position in the near future.
- Dr. Beresford reported that he attended the Carmel Youth Assistance Program's Board Meeting. He stated that CYAP has been a wonderful asset to the community and their organization has been life changing for many students and families.
- Dr. Beresford stated that his "listening tour" is in progress. He has enjoyed meeting with the CCS Board, parents, community members, principals, and even a few students. He was particularly impressed by our principals whom he described has being "smart with heart" in serving the students and families in their school communities. In addition, he reported that he had very positive meetings with the Carmel Education Foundation directors, as well as, the Carmel Teacher's Association officers.
- Dr. Beresford shared that is scheduling a meeting with Reverend Shelly Wood from Orchard Park Presbyterian Church to begin the discussion for future use of the Orchard Park Elementary campus. Although the changes are three years away, he is looking forward to positive and collaborative discussions on how to keep the building and property a vibrant part of the community.
- Dr. Beresford reported that the "Bellringer" of his report was the "C4" professional development conference he attended. He mentioned that over half of the CCS teaching staff took time out of their summer break to "Connect, Collect, Colaborate, and Create" with colleagues to grow professionally and better serve our students. CCS teachers and administrators presented most of the sessions. It was simply an outstanding professional development experience.
