➤ **Review the proposed S.I.P for the 18-19 school year.**

--Discussed the SIP goals and results from 2016-2017

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--Reviewed and discussed current progress on SIP goals for 2018-2019 (\$46,665 budget):

1) 92% attendance rate per grade level in $\frac{3}{4}$ terms or more....currently at 95%...no trustlands \$ needed for this goal

2) Continue with the Assessment to Achievement program as a school utilizing the CTT process with grade levels, under the direction of the ELA coordinator....continue to hold grade level CTT's every other week with administration attending as able...no Trustlands \$ needed for this goal

3) At least 60% of each K-3 grade level will show at least typical progress or better in the End of Year Dibels results as measured through Pathways of Progress...Used Trustland

funds to hire & Pay salary for two reading instructional aides, who work under the direction of the classroom teacher, and to pay for technology for these aides to utilize in working with students

4) Raise the Sage (now RISE) proficiency scores in grades 3-6 from 35% to 38% or better...Used Trustland funds to hire & pay salary for two math instructional aides, to purchase math technology, such as Reflex Math and Go Math. Administrative intern, Lori James, will plan and carryout a school wide Math night to build math motivation and offer fun ways to practice math at home

5) The Staff will participate in professional development in an effort to refine curriculum mapping & essential skills for daily instruction...The staff participated in a two day LEAN training with 3 other schools to learn how to wean out non-essentials and refine practice and planning...Used \$5000 in Trustlands to pay for the training...accountability is through Davis Evaluates showing that teachers are planning, teaching, and providing an organized environment on specific standards observed and by sharing LEAN ideas on the TEAMS app with the 3 other schools who participated in the training.
