## Dana Middle School 2018-2019 Bicycle, Scooter and Skateboard Permission Slip

The policy of the Wiseburn School District allows students in grades six through eight to ride their bicycles, scooters and skateboards to school. Increasing traffic makes safety a major concern for all of us.

Please share the following standards with your child if they plan to ride to Dana School during the 2018-2019 school year. The form at the bottom of this page must be signed and returned to the Dana Office before your child can begin to ride to school.

Students must follow the following rules:

- 1. Students must ride as close as possible to the right side curb.
- 2. Students are not allowed to ride on the sidewalks in front of Cabrillo, Burnett, Dana, or Anza schools, the Wiseburn Library, or the Wiseburn district office.
- 3. Riding double is not permitted at any time.
- 4. Students must walk across the street at intersections. Students will not cross in the middle of the block.
- 5. Students with bicycles must enter and exit through the parking lot entrance on 135<sup>th</sup> Street.
- 6. The bike lock area is located outside the main gates, on the west side of the administration building. Students are not allowed to ride or walk bicycles inside campus at any time.
- 7. Bicycles shall be locked individually in the bike rack. Locks and chains may not be left overnight at school. (the bike rack area is locked during school hours and after 4:30 pm)
- 8. Students may not loiter in the bike rack area before or after school.
- 9. Scooters and skateboards shall be locked individually in the racks located by the gym. **Students are not allowed to ride or walk scooters/skateboards inside campus at any time.**
- 10. Bicycles shall be maintained in a safe condition. We recommend that your bicycle be marked with serial #, model, driver's license number and/or bicycle license number.
- 11. State law requires that bicycle helmets be worn when riding a bicycle, scooter or skateboard.
- 12. Bicycle helmets are stored in homeroom until the end of the day.
- 13. Every student must have a Dana MS sticker affixed to their bicycle, scooter or skateboard. If no sticker is visible, the school has the right to confiscate the item and a parent may be required to pick it up.

<u>Consequences</u>: Depending on the seriousness and frequency of the infraction, consequences issued will range from a warning to the loss of riding privileges for a specified period of time to suspension. Students who are not wearing helmets will not be allowed to retrieve their bikes, scooters, or skateboards after school until a parent/guardian picks it up. Dana School and/or the Wiseburn School District cannot accept responsibility for damage or theft.
