SCHOOL BOARD REPORT:

At the April 17th School Board Workshop and Meeting, extraordinary teachers, students and staff were recognized. The board approved expenses related to the insurance claim for the bus garage. Also approved was modular classroom purchases.

On April 27th was the 2018/2019 budget seminar. The seminar was very thorough and educational and explained how the responsible budget was put together.

At the May 15th School Board Workshop, the increased tax rate of 1.92% was unveiled by Mr. Vignone. (This is under the 2.4% tax increase cap set by the act 1 index). Mr. bold was given the first ever Parkland Education Association Friend Award. At the meeting held directly after the workshop, the Board approved the purchase of new buses destroyed by the fire.

May 22nd is the next School Board Meeting where the budget is expected to be adopted.
