Recipe

Cool Cucumber Sushi Rolls

1 Cup Sushi Rice to 2 cups water
1 ½ Tbs sugar
2 Cucumber
2 Raw Carrots
1 TBS rice vinegar
3 TBSP water
2 large sheets of dried nori
Sweet ginger, Sliced
Soy Sauce

1. Cook rice, let cool, add sugar.
2. Peel cucumbers and carrots, cut into 4 inch strips.
3. Mix rice vinegar with

water.

4. Place one nori sheet shiny side down on a bamboo mat. Moisten hands with vinegar and water mixture and spread rice $\frac{1}{4}$ inch thick on nori sheet, leaving an inch at each end. Lay several slices of cucumber and carrots on the rice. Carefully roll up in bamboo mat. Unroll the mat and let stay for 5 minutes before slicing into 2 inch pieces.
