Content	Learning Focus	Resources
Code of Conduct & Behaviour Discuss the Code of Conduct with pupils, giving examples of good and unacceptable behaviour. Tell pupils about RMA's "Caught being good", but stress this behaviour is expected at all times.	To foster a polite and supportive ethos throughout school To establish a common understanding of expected pupil behaviour	Code of Conduct on Classroom wall
Ground Rules	Establish ground rules for your class to create a safe environment for discussions	See INSET notes (under admin if you don't have them) for ideas Pupils can have a say in the class ground rules. This is a good opportunity to use debating skills, voting systems and explain the term democracy.
Target Setting	Establish targets for Autumn term	Record of Achievement books. Please ensure targets are SMART Posters for display boards.
Team Building	Getting to know each other and working as a team	1. Cooperation Game : Pass round a tambourine without making a noise. Then discuss – how did they feel when...eg someone made a noise etc... use as a trigger for discussions on team work, cooperation, personalities, individuals... 2. Teambuilding books and activities on PSHEE shelf in library

		3. Outdoor learning cards on M drive. Equipment is in the Outdoor Learning shed by the Wren's adventure playground. See IML/LPK for assistance.
<p>Social Skills – To tie in with the Anti-Bullying/positive friendships talk on the 19th September</p> <p>1. Pupils play the board games in pairs, then feed back to the class what they have learned, triggering discussions.</p> <p>2. Read book about Telling lies, then discuss</p> <p>3. The Power of words</p> <p>4. Being unique</p>	<p>1. Topics addressed include manners, morals, emotions, empathy and friendship</p> <p>2. To consider the consequences of telling lies</p> <p>3. To understand the power of words, boost-ups and put downs and discuss the enormous positive effect of kind words</p>	<p>1. Social Skills board games (in staffroom)</p> <p>2. “Does Wilmot tell lies?” scanned book</p> <p>3. The Power of words Read story, 2 pupils sit in the middle one with a pile of stars to count the positive things said and one with circles to count the put downs. Place one of either on the floor as comments are made. At end count up stars and circles. Use as a trigger for discussions on how Sarah felt at the end of the day, what made her feel that way, would we prefer boosts or put-downs, does anyone like giving out stars? Circles? Why...honesty...</p> <p>Alternately you could give the children a copy of a body each and ask them to tear a bit off each time a negative comment is made.</p> <p>4. Read “Something Else” by Chris Riddell (in Year 4 PSHE box in the staff room). Great book about uniqueness, difference and collaboration</p>
