### CAREERS

If a student is **not** interested in attending college, there are numerous vocational opportunities, especially in the Dallas area.

- ☑ The Armed Services also provide good career opportunities if the person can accept the time, commitment and group regimentation. Armed Services recruiters always provide the counselor's offices with some information on their programs (both active duty and reserves). The recruiters also have offices in the Mesquite area. The ASVAB will be given at NMHS on December 6th. [Armedforcescareers.com](http://Armedforcescareers.com) is a good place to start exploring your options.
- ☑ The Texas Employment Commission can help a person obtain a job by utilizing a computerized list of positions in the Dallas area. This list includes skilled and unskilled jobs.
- ☑ The high school and public libraries also contain relevant occupational information that would pertain to all students.
- ☑ Paid Apprenticeships are available for most trades (carpentry, plumbing, electricians, etc). Local Unions are the primary sources of information here.
