GENERAL CONDITIONS

A. INTENT

It is the intent of this document to specify our needs for instruments to support the district music program.

B. SCOPE OF WORK

Proposals shall include the products and delivery to the Madison Public Schools: complete, functional, and ready to use instruments according to the specifications in this document.

C. WARRANTY

The complete instrument package shall be accompanied by Vendor warranties on instrument defects and/or defects to be repaired or replaced through normal use.

D. COMPLETION/DELIVERY:

Units will be complete and delivered to the Town of Madison, between 15 and 45 days from date of order.

E. UNIT SPECIFICATIONS

- Units shall be in an enclosed instrument case for protection and storage as described in chart below.
- Unit shall include a set of appropriate cleaning materials and a starter set of consumables needed as specified for initial use.
- Units shall be new, of first quality, and free of any defects or flaws.
