EXTRA ACTIVITIES TUITION INFORMATION

DANCE

Royal Academy of Dance Classical Ballet and Imperial Society Teachers of Dance Modern/Jazz and Tap

All dance classes are available as individual, shared or group lessons, usually 60 minutes in duration. On the application form please state what genre you require, where previously trained, the last dance examination taken (with date) and the level and number of dance lessons now required.

LANGUAGES

GCSE Chinese

Native speakers of Mandarin or Cantonese can take their GCSE Chinese in Year 10 and upwards.

A Level Chinese

Only pupils in the Sixth Form (Years 12 and 13) will be able to take the new A level examinations. Pupils will be expected to attend fortnightly sessions of 60 minutes for the Autumn and Spring terms. These group sessions are not chargeable to parents.

Italian

This is currently available for pupils as private individual lessons. The course is for beginners and, subject to demand and capability of the pupil, may lead to external examination.

Japanese

This is currently available for pupils as private individual, paired or group sessions. The course is for beginners and, subject to demand and capability of the pupil, may lead to external examination.

Independent Examination Entry for Native Speakers

This is only available for Years 10, 11, 12 & 13 and, in exceptional cases Year 9 where agreed by the Head of Faculty, who are native or near native speakers of another language and/or hold existing qualifications for that language and wish to **independently** take an examination at GCSE/AS/A2 Level. No tuition is provided and there is no staff involvement beyond the examination entry, apart from one briefing meeting if the examination board is Edexcel or AQA. Pupils will also have to arrange for an external examiner to be able to take the speaking part of their examination.

MUSIC

Instrumental Tuition

Individual instrumental tuition is available for the following instruments: *Bassoon, Cello, Clarinet, Double Bass, Drum Kit, Flute, French Horn, Guitar, Harp, Oboe, Orchestral Percussion, Organ, Piano, Recorder, Saxophone, Solo Singing, Trombone, Trumpet, Viola and Violin.*

Individual lessons

Individual lessons will be offered as follows and as required by pupils and their parents. As a guideline the Music Department suggests the following provision:

Beginners-Grade 5 Music Pupils	30 minute lessons (Standard)
Grade 6-7 & GCSE Music Pupils	45 minute lessons (Intermediate)
Grade 8 & above, AS & A2 Music Pupils	60 minute lessons (Advanced)

Special Instruments Lesson Schemes

The Music Department offers an excellent scheme to promote the apprenticeship of exciting instruments: *Bassoon, Cello, Double bass, French Horn, Oboe, Orchestral Percussion, Organ, Trombone, Trumpet and Viola*. These instruments are readily available in the department and the following schemes are open to all Roedean musicians (please note – all applicants will require an initial interview with the Head of Music):

Scheme 1: Taster in a special instrument

We offer ten FREE lessons in one of the above instruments as a taster for talented pupils.

Scheme 2: Special instrument as a second study

All pupils studying at least one instrument at Roedean are invited to take up a Special Instrument at a reduced cost. This reduction of 50% of the fees is valid for the duration of the tuition.

Scheme 3: Special instrument for music pupils

All GCSE and A Level music pupils are eligible to apply for FREE tuition in a Special Instrument as part of their studies at Roedean.

Please note

Although most pupils are expected to provide their own instruments, the school has a number of instruments for hire. Pupils starting a new instrument are recommended to purchase their own instrument(s) after the first year of study.

On the application form, please state which instrument(s) and/or extra subjects required, plus current music grade.

SPEECH & DRAMA, ACTING & SPOKEN COMMUNICATION

Lessons in Speech and Drama, Acting and Spoken Communication are offered and can be taken by any pupil on an individual basis or with a partner. All lessons are 30 minutes long. Pupils may enter for LAMDA or English Speaking Board examinations. As from September, we are also offering LAMDA Musical Theatre grades. The pupil(s) and teacher should discuss all the options available and which are most suitable to ensure optimum progress and enjoyment.

SPORTS

Horse Riding/Hacking: group classes are available throughout the school year. Equipment (hat, boots, etc) can be purchased at school.

Karate and Kick Boxing: Group classes are available throughout the school year. Equipment (suit, mitts), licence, gradings and seminars are costed and charged separately.

Squash, Tennis, Table Tennis and Golf: Professional one-to-one or shared coaching is available throughout the school year. Pupils will need to provide their own squash and tennis rackets; golf equipment will be provided. For Year 10 pupils and upwards, Golf Club Membership at East Brighton Golf Club (just 5 minutes drive from Roedean) is available.
