The methodology used for long range planning falls into three categories:

 - (1) the gathering of information and data,
 - (2) the analysis of that information and data, and
 - (3) the development of options for the future of the district - improving facilities or adding new facilities - based on the data and the analysis.
- Define Committee's Goal and Structure
 - Intentional membership - a voice for our community's taxpayer
 - Ex-Officio members = Non-voting
 - Firm timeline to vote date
 - Determine next steps in Facilities to best support our District's mission and vision
 - Committee member commitment to 12 months (no summer mtgs)
- Define Timeline - "Start with the end in mind"
 - Committee Work Timeline
 - From no work to facility renovations to new schools - Continuum
 - Final Draft Recommendation to Board
 - Oct 22, 2019
 - Initial Recommendation Presentation to Board
 - Sept 24, 2019
 - Aug 2018 through November 2019, Summer months off
 - 3rd Tues of each month = ~1 ½ hour monthly mtg
 - 2 Saturdays btwn now and winter = Tour all District Schools on a Yellow Bus

- **Earliest Possible Facility Project Vote Date** - Tuesday, March 10, 2020
 - If Board decides to ask our community for facility funding (Bond or Plant-Facility Levy)
- Gather Data - Future Meetings
 - School District policies and procedures
 - Description of program uses of facilities
 - Grade configuration information - Lisa's Educational Alignment Subcommittee
 - Student enrollment histories and District projections
 - School class size protocols (targets)
 - Capacity Analysis
 - Facility Assessments
 - Floor plans or diagrams of school facilities
 - Site Visits
 - Budget/Finance
 - Look at perimeter district timeline so committee knows the full scope of District
