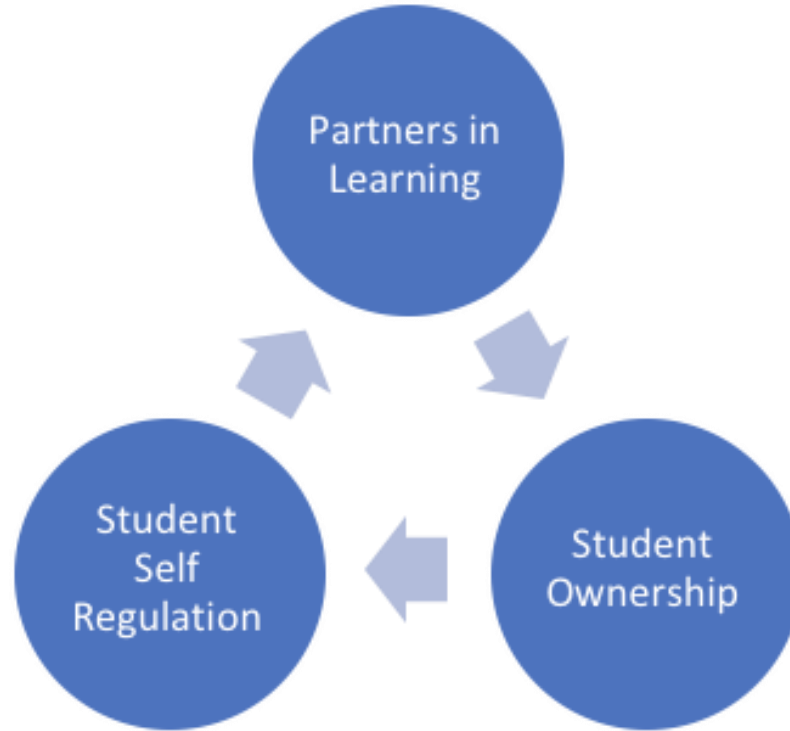

Personalized Learning in the GPS is:

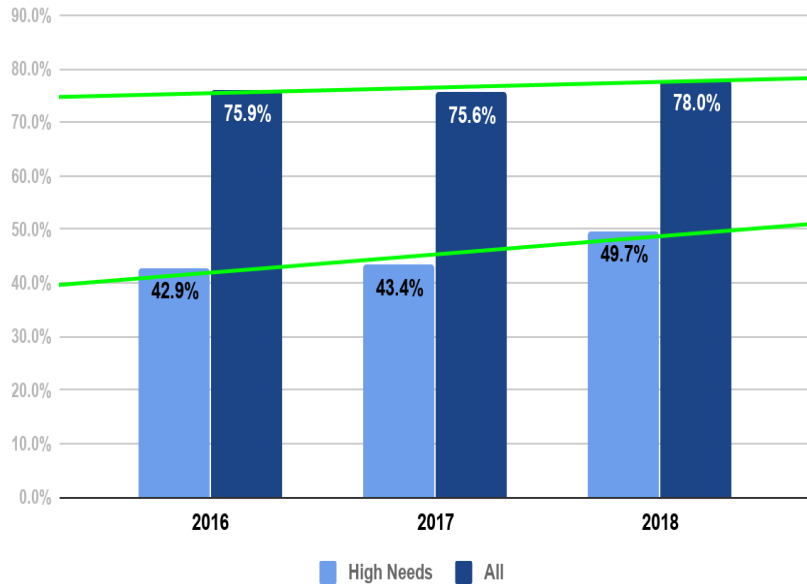
- ❖ a teacher facilitated process

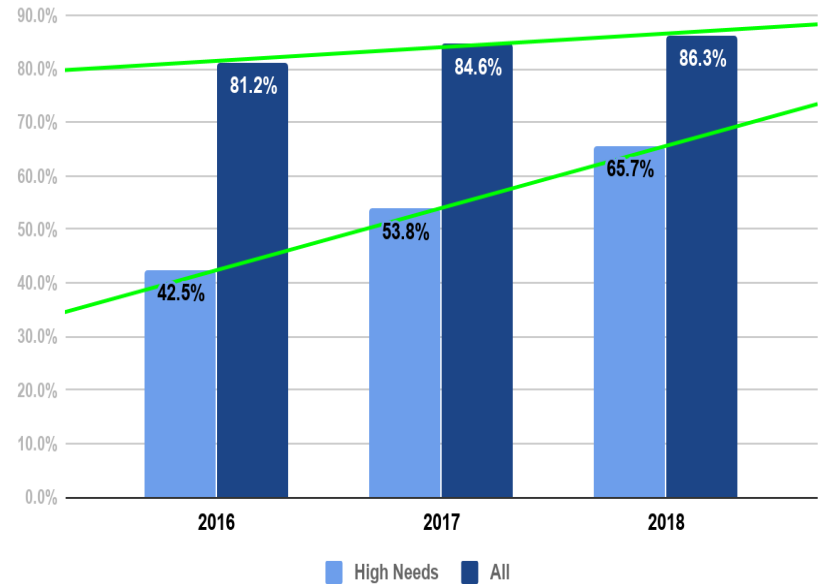


English Language Arts - Grades 3-8, 11

Grades 3-8 - Meets/Exceeds Benchmark

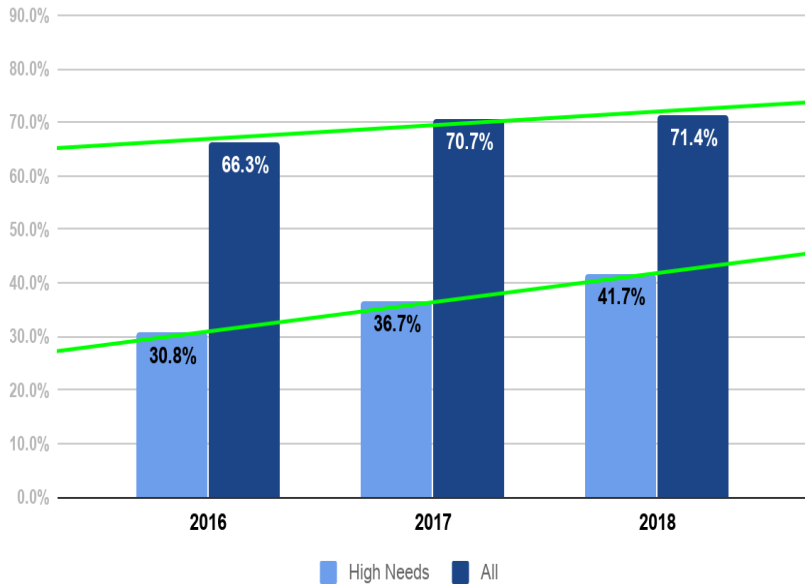


Grade 11 - Meets/Exceeds Benchmark

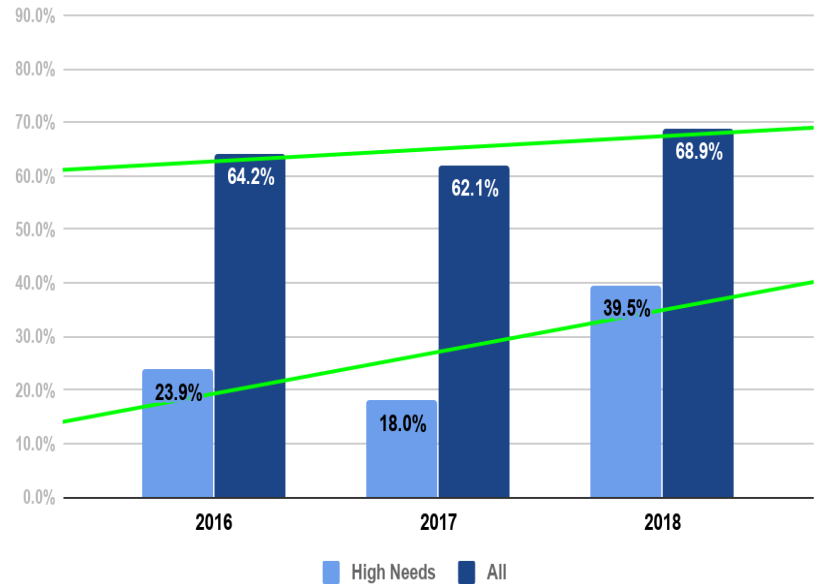


Mathematics - Grades 3-8, 11
