HALLOWEEN/FALL CELEBRATION PARADE

Our Halloween parade will begin at **approximately 9:15 a.m.** on Wednesday, October 31st <u>The stu-</u> dents should come to school already dressed in their costumes that day. Please do not plan on doing student make-up and other costume details at school. This must be done at home BEFORE the beginning of the school day. Students in grades 1-6 should bring a change of regular school clothes to change into after Halloween festivities. **Regular school clothing should be worn following the Halloween festivities.** It's recommended that when possible, students wear their regular clothes under their costumes.

To ensure safety during the parade, please note the following safety restrictions on costumes:

- \Box No weapons, real or pretend
- □ No roller blades/skateboards/scooters
- No live animals
- □ No clothing and/or adornments which depict illegal substances
- □ Masks should not be worn by any adults
- □ No gory costumes
- □ No strapless costumes, mid-drifts, short-shorts/skirts.

HALLOWEEN PARADE LOCATION FOR PARENTS

We are asking that ALL parents and visitors during the parade stay in the gym/stage/front hall area until the entire parade is over. For the safety of the students, parents are invited to wait in the gym to watch the Halloween parade fun! As the parade route winds its way through school hallways, please stay in the gym as to decrease the congestion in the hall-ways. Pre-school age children need to be under parent supervision at all times - not with school age siblings

* Please note: the parade begins at 9:15, but takes at least 15 minutes to make it to the gym where parents will be viewing the parade.

After students have paraded through the gym, they parade around the school one more time so that they can see the costumes of all of the students. Due to this, we need to keep the halls clear of all parents until the conclusion of the parade. When the parade is over, we will make an announcement letting everyone know that the halls will be open for parents. Thank you in advance for following this procedure.
