Cost	Total cost of the conference is approximately \$1,200 for tuition, airfare, room, and board. Students selected to attend the conference are asked to pay \$400 toward the total cost.
Notification	Semi-finalists will be notified by December 14, 2018 and will be invited for an interview with members of the Utah Chapter Board of Trustees in Salt Lake City on Saturday, January 5, 2019 or in Gunnison on Saturday, January 12, 2019 . (Travel expenses to be covered by the student.) Notification of scholarship awards will be <u>sent</u> by January 18, 2019. Between 40–50 students (20-25 per group) will be chosen to attend one of the two sessions of the conference at the Freedoms Foundation national campus in Valley Forge, Pennsylvania.
Alternates	If for some reason you are unable to attend the Conference on your assigned date, an alternate will be sent in your stead.
Commitment	All selected students will be presented, along with their parents, at the Freedoms Foundation Heroes Luncheon in Salt Lake City in February, 2019. A mandatory orientation meeting for students and parents will be held that same day and place, immediately following the luncheon.




