- The retreats are held at Camp Don Bosco and scholarships are available.

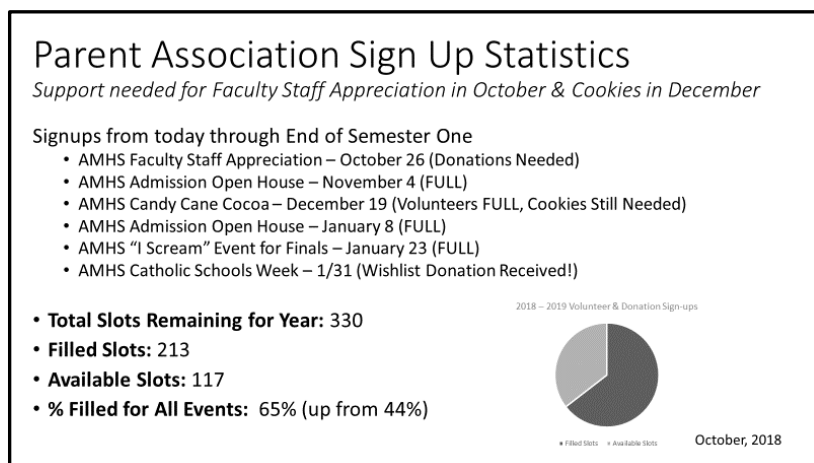
❖ Athletics – Mark Leone
