5 Subcommittee Updates		 The "Enhancing Play Spaces" Subcommittee will meet for the first time on Friday, January 12, 2018. The "Technology and Keyboarding at VPS" Subcommittee met on Thursday, January 4th. At the meeting, the history of technology and keyboarding at VPS was discussed, as well as the focus on keyboarding instruction given the shift to computer based testing. Michele Linse, library media specialist, shared what she learned through an initial search for research, which was very little has actually been studied about best practices related to keyboarding instruction. For the next meeting, members are reading guidelines from the New York State Education Department and collecting information about keyboarding instruction from local school districts to bring back for review. 			 Members agree children learn typing by integrating it into what they are already doing. The NYS Assessments are one little part of what we do as a school. We recognize the need for increased technology to allow for more technology integration. There needs to be a balance between technology and other instructional areas. How do we ensure equitable opportunity to technology for all children? Consider comparing assessment results from this school year to previous school years to see if there is any correlation to scores and socioeconomic status.

6	Goal Work: Enhancing Parent Connections		 The goal for this work was reviewed: VPS Building Council will review current methods of home/school connections currently in place, survey staff and parents to better understand areas of strength and need, make recommendations, and outline a plan to incorporate any shifts and/or enhancements. Conversation regarding this goal area included: Members agreed to keep communication and connection areas together instead of exploring one or the other. Connection opportunities initiated by classroom teachers are typically well attended. From a parent perspective, it is difficult for parents to connect with other parents given the size of the school and typical 2-year time frame children are in the building. What could be done to increase this sense of parent/parent connection? To gain further information from a teacher perspective about parent communication/connections, building council teacher representatives will survey their colleagues at an upcoming grade level meeting, asking about how they communicate with parents, what they use, if they would be willing to help other colleagues use tools they are using, what is working, what they struggle with, and what ideas they have.
