

PowerTeacher Pro

You do not have to install anything to run PowerTeacher Pro. Pro is completely browser based. PowerTeacher Pro will run on a ipad, smart phone or chromebook. You can run it from anywhere!

Tips:

- On the start page click PowerTeacher Pro on left side of screen or under a subject.



- First time you click on PowerTeacher Pro you will get a Welcome to PowerTeacher Pro screen just click the x on the upper right side to close the screen you can get it back anytime by clicking on the (?) help top right hand side of your screen.

- Comment are always entered in the last standard in the row. The identifier ends in CO and has a little note in the upper right hand corner.


