Membership – Bylaws:

It was recommended that we reduce the number of people in the community council by eliminating one parent and one teacher spot. Dr. Hadlock proposed that the Council consists of 7 parents and 5 employees from the 8 parents and 6 employees currently. Shelly Thorne will switch from an employee position to a parent position this current year making the current Council's numbers 7 parents and 5 employees.

It was recommended to elect for new members in the council in the spring instead of waiting until the fall.

Trustland Reports:

Financial Update: Dr. Hadlock reviewed the current spending of the Trustland funds from each goal.

With using \$4000 of the school's money, the school's STS was able to refresh all classroom's projectors one year earlier than planned because of the funding from the Trustlands.

Mrs. Barton, a member of the English department, explained how the PLC conference was very beneficial to the department and the training will be used immediately in the classroom. She also explained how the grader, who is paid through Trustland accounts, has greatly benefited the department and student progress.

Student Language Concern:

The Council discussed how it can redirect bad language in the hallways. A committee was created to develop a plan on how to handle bad language: Jenny Schow, Jennifer Affleck, Vicki Hassard, and the student government.
