5. ILP Discussion

- Feedback on how to make the ILPs better
 - Challenges
 - Back to back scheduling of conference does not allow any flexibility. Most teachers were perpetually off schedule.
 - Multiple days of early outs are challenging for parents
 - Student led conferences are often not effective without proper training
 - 15 minute ILPs are not long enough for a child with any type of concern.
 - Potential solutions
 - Give buffer time between ILP time slots
 - Take one full day off in lieu of multiple early days
 - Better training of teachers, students and parents for Student Led ILPs
 - Minimum of 30 minute time slots
 - Some other schools do stations
