Community Council Elections will be during the month of April. Three new members will be elected.

School Improvement Plan – Goal - Write to gain the most for each grade.

1. 7 & 8th Grade English – Productivity (low class size) (teacher training).
English for 7th Grade double block.
2. CTE (Project Lead the Way) Engineering – Implementing costs for training and growth – Intro to Construction
3. Technology and Equipment for classroom Instruction – Every Dept.
4. PLC – Professional Learning Community – Use Common Assessments and curriculum mapping.

Money from Trustlands to meet goals:

Project Lead the Way – Paid for with other funding.

\$10,000 -Technology & Equipment (Administration will apply for a \$5,000 matching grant from the District Foundation.

\$6,000 - Knight Discovery (reduced to two teachers instead of three)

\$8,000 - Credit Recovery during school (Productivity during Study class)

\$6,000 - PLC & Teacher Training (curriculum mapping –common assessments)

\$57,000 - Productivity (Reduce class sizes) allows double blocking.

\$3,000 – Expected Carryover
