1. Rebecca Pond started Community Council welcoming all members old and new. Rebecca handed out an updated contact list which is posted on the web page.
2. Minutes were reviewed and approved from May (Terrie), There was some discussion about the last year landtrust report which was explained and approved. A yearly calendar was presented.

4. Mr. Brown discussed the beginning of the new school year. Many successful things are underway or have been accomplished already, such as 7th Grade Rally and class schedule changes. The Councilors will begin teaching in the CCR classes. Beginning in September the councilors will prepare the 8th Grade class with information about high school registration, scholarships, high school graduation requirements. Mr. Brown talked about HOPE SQUAD and the positive affects it is having on the KJH Community.
5. Digital Citizenship: Community Council is considering a different name for Guardian Insider as parents are not recognizing it as a resource.
