The most helpful thing is having the support of someone who is a parent themselves and also has child development training to help navigate the highs and lows of the parenting experience.

Even though we feel very engaged with our child's development, and rather "studious" about how we can be better/smarter parents, we always manage to learn new things. And we appreciate that we can ask "weird" questions and get answers that are meaningful.
