## Running Club Reminder

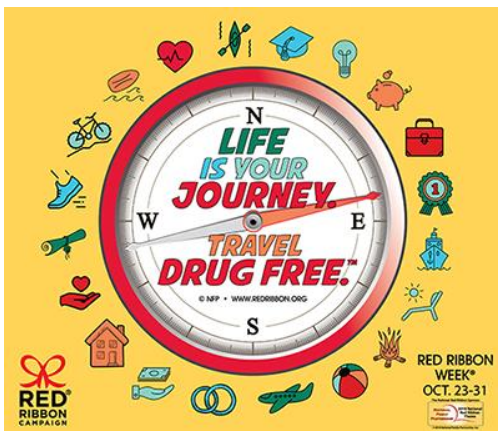

Stricter requirements are in place for parent notes this school year.
