ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

The St. Joseph's Academy Athletic Hall of Fame honors women and men who have made significant contributions to athletics at SJA. It recognizes those individuals whose distinguished careers or outstanding dedication have furthered the excellence of the athletic program; whose actions have promoted and supported athletics as a vital pillar of the SJA mission statement; and who embody the values of character, honor and sportsmanship.

MEMBERSHIP:

Induction into the Hall of Fame is the highest honor bestowed upon those who act to preserve the spirit and heritage of Redsticker athletics in one of three categories: Student-Athlete, Coach or Contributor/Distinguished Volunteer.

Membership in the St. Joseph's Academy Athletic Hall of Fame honors any person, living or deceased, who has demonstrated outstanding dedication to the athletic program; whose actions portray characteristics which further the mission of St. Joseph's Academy; and whose life and accomplishments serve as an inspiration to the student-athletes of St. Joseph's Academy.

NOMINATIONS:

Nominations are accepted from the public at large and should be submitted by August 1 of each year.

RATIFICATION OF INDUCTEES:

Nominations are submitted to the SJA Athletic Director. Final decisions are made by the St. Joseph's Academy Athletic Hall of Fame Nomination Committee.

NUMBER OF INDUCTEES PER YEAR:

No more than three inductees will be selected each year.

INDUCTION:

Hall of Fame inductees are honored at the St. Joseph's Academy Athletic Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony held each year in February.

AWARD:

Inductees receive a plaque at the recognition dinner. Inductees' names are part of the Hall of Fame plaque on campus. Inductees' pictures are displayed for the year of induction on the plaque.

CATEGORIES

STUDENT-ATHLETE: A woman who experienced outstanding achievement as a competitor in a sport while enrolled at St. Joseph's Academy. A student-athlete is eligible for membership a minimum of 10 years after graduation from high school.

COACH: A person who experienced outstanding achievement as a coach at St. Joseph's Academy. A nominee must have at least 10 years of coaching experience to be eligible for induction.

CONTRIBUTOR/DISTINGUISHED VOLUNTEER: Any person whose activities as a volunteer or school supporter have resulted in outstanding service to the St. Joseph's Academy athletic department. A nominee must have provided a minimum of 10 years of exceptional service to be eligible for induction.
