The Church is a 501(c)(3) exempt organization. All entities of the Church, including the Diocese and St. John Chrysostom Episcopal Church and School, derive their tax exempt status as 501(c)(3) institutions from the status of the Church of which they are a part. Dear Sir or Madam:

This is in response to your request of August 5, 2003 regarding a copy of your organization's group exemption letter.

In January 1940 we issued a determination letter that recognized your organization as exempt from federal income tax. Our records indicate that your organization is currently exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Based on the information submitted, we recognized the subordinates named on the list your organization supplied as exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Also, we classified those subordinates as organizations that are not private foundations because they are organizations of the type described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i) of the Code.

Donors may deduct contributions to your organization's subordinates as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers or gifts to the subordinates or for their use are deductible for federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

Your organization and its subordinates are not required to file federal income tax returns unless subject to the tax on unrelated business income under section 511 of the Code. If subject to this tax, the organization must file an income tax return on Form 990-T, *Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return*. In this letter, we are not determining whether any of your organization or its subordinates' present or proposed activities are unrelated trade or business as defined in section 513 of the Code.

Unless specifically excepted, your organization and its subordinates are liable for taxes under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) on remuneration of \$100 or more paid each employee during a calendar year. This does not apply, however, if your organization makes or has made a timely election under section 3121(w) of the Code to be exempt from such tax. Your organization and its subordinates are not liable for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).



Dear Madams and Sirs:

In a May 10, 2001 letter, a copy of which is attached, the Internal Revenue Service reaffirmed the tax exempt status of the Episcopal Church and many of its dioceses with their congregations and other entities that the Church included in its Application for Group Exemption Number, dated April 4, 2001. Since that date, the Church has been informed of a small number of changes among the dioceses, congregations, and other entities covered by its group exemption. The Church has periodically notified the IRS of these changes and asked the IRS to amend its roster of covered organizations accordingly.

This letter contains an up-dated list of dioceses, congregations, and other entities to be covered by the Church's group exemption.

- (3) a written authorization by each diocese to be covered under the group exemption.



Each diocese has represented to the Episcopal Church that at its headquarters as shown in the enclosed list it maintains:


- (1) a list of the employer identification number of each covered congregation;

Sirs:

It is the opinion of this office, based upon the evidence presented, that you are exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101(6) of the Internal Revenue Code and corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.

Accordingly, you will not be required to file returns of income unless you change the character of your organization, the purposes for which you were organized, or your method of operation. Any such changes should be reported immediately to the collector of internal revenue for your district in order that their effect upon your exempt status may be determined.

Since any organization which is exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101 of the Internal Revenue Code also is exempt from the capital stock tax pursuant to the express provisions of section 1201(a)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code, you will not be required to file capital stock tax returns for future years so long as the exemption from income tax is effective.

Furthermore, under substantially identical authority contained in sections 1426 and 1607 of the Code and/or corresponding provisions of the Social Security Act, the employment taxes imposed by such statutes are not applicable to remuneration for services performed in your employ so long as you meet the conditions prescribed above for retention of an exempt status for income tax purposes.

Contributions made to you are deductible by the donors in arriving at their taxable net income in the manner and to the extent provided by section 23(o) and (q) of the Internal Revenue Code and corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.



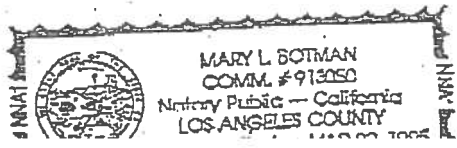

The Diocese of Los Angeles is an affiliated Diocese and institution of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America. The "Episcopal Churches and Dioceses in the United States and Institutions Thereof, New York, N.Y." (Code 1) are listed as exempt organizations on page 508 of Publication 78, the *Cumulative List of Organizations described in Section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986*. In accordance with the cumulative list, Code 1 is "Generally, a central organization holding a group exemption letter, whose subordinate units covered by the group exemption are also included as having contributions deductible, even though they are not separately listed." A current listing of all dioceses and institutions with federal a state identifications is available upon request.

The Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society of The Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America obtained a determination letter, dated March 23, 1942, from the Internal Revenue Service that under then Section 101(6), which is equivalent to Section 501(c)(3) of the current Internal Revenue Code, the organization was exempt from federal income tax. In a subsequent letter dated June 3, 1971, the Internal Revenue Service confirmed the organization's exempt status under Section 501(c)(3). Thus, The Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America is currently a 501(c)(3) exempt organization. The Society is currently listed in Publication 78 on page 453.

The Episcopal Church in the U.S.A. is comprised of 98 domestic dioceses and 22 missionary dioceses. All churches and missions are members of a diocese in their geographical area. Each diocese is autonomous. The governing body of the Episcopal Church is the General Convention which meet every three years. The on-going everyday responsibility of the Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the U.S.A., Inc. (hereinafter called "The Society"). The Executive Council elected by the General Convention and the nine provinces of the Church, is the Board of Directors of "The Society" and the presiding Bishop is the President.

It is for this reason we are listed three times in the "Cumulative List of Organizations" as described in section 170 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (see Cumulative List of Organizations as revised to October 31, 1983).

Listed as "Episcopal Churches and Dioceses in the United States and Institutions, New York, NY (Code 1)". Code 1 as defined by Department of the Treasury, Internal Revenue Services is "generally a central organization holding a group exemption letter, whose subordinate units covered by the group exemption are also included as having contributions deductible even though they are separately listed".

Also listed as "Protestant Episcopal Churches and Dioceses in the United States, New York, NY". Also listed as Code 1.

Also listed "Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America, New York, NY."

"The Society" has the unique role of conducting the affairs of the Church between General Conventions and operates on a nation-wide, day-to-day basis. Apparently, it is for this reason the Internal Revenue exemption determination letter is addressed in the name of "The Society".

The listing of "The Society" in the foregoing manner should help to establish the deductibility of individual gifts to particular parishes and dioceses, although the Internal Revenue Service may take the position that the listing does not necessarily establish such deductibility.
