**Responsibilities:** The Upper School Spanish Teacher will report to the Head of Upper School and will:

- Be responsible for teaching four Spanish classes to students possibly ranging from grades 6 -12 and willing and able to teach multiple levels Spanish 1-AP)
- Spanish AP or IB teaching experience preferred
- Effectively collaborate with a team of 9 Spanish teachers.

In addition to the normal teaching responsibilities, this person will advise a group of 10 students, supervise a study hall for one semester, and perform periodic duty assignments (lunch, traffic, detention, etc.).

**Qualifications:** A bachelor's degree in Spanish Education, Advanced Mid or higher proficiency and five years, or more, of direct teaching experience in the field is preferred; a master's degree is preferred. Candidates should have a strong academic background and possess proficient technology skills. In addition, the candidate should have superb organizational skills, excellent verbal and written communication skills, and the ability to collaborate effectively as a team member. Preference will be given to candidates who have a working knowledge of the ACTFL proficiency standards, who currently teach to the three modes of communication, and who are dedicated to creating lessons and activities centered on the learner.
