## **CESIT CLASSES – Third Session**

### **Art**

Then the art from this class will be judged and those chosen will be in the SBISD Rodeo Art Exhibit!!!

Please note: (new this year) You will have to provide your own photos to work from. So, family photos and especially those you take yourself will be needed. Everyone is welcome!!!!

### **Basketball**

Do you like to play hoops? Then sign up for Basketball! In this class, students will play basketball games like horse, around the world, and scrimmage each other. There will also be student-teacher challenges throughout the class. Bring your game and be prepared to have fun.

### **Brain Research**

Dive deeper into understanding the workings of the brain, learning how it works from the inside out.

### **CNN Newscast**

Are you interested in learning how to create videos? Do you want to be a part of the announcements? Are you motivated and a self-starter? Come and learn how to make a really great newscast for the daily school announcements.

### **Cooking**

Students will create a current events notebook where they will record and map the day's happenings. We will also go to the opposite end of the pendulum and create /explore through Makerspace every Tuesday and Thursday.

### **Exploring Korean Cultures**

Learn about Korea from lifestyles, trends, history, and food. Taught by Joanne Kim from the district Bilingual Department.

### **Gamesapalooza**

Plus, creating handmade items is a great way to put your heart into the season of giving.

### **Keyboarding**
