17-18 School Improvement Plan Final Review and Vote

The District held its SIP Review meeting in smaller formats allowing all junior highs to meet together in a cooperative process following a direct review by District personnel. The CJH SIP was reviewed and approved as submitted and approved by the Council in March.

• 17-18(18-19) Community Council Election Plan Update

Elections will be the second week of May. It appears that all council members up for re-election are seeking to continue on the Council.
