# Join us for the Terry Fox Run Hong Kong

# The Terry Fox Run is a great opportunity for our school to make a difference in the fight against cancer. We hope you can join us in this community event.



In 1977, Terry Fox was an active 18 year old Canadian who was diagnosed with bone cancer. He was forced to have his right leg amputated. While in hospital, Terry's concern for other cancer patients inspired him to run the Marathon of Hope, a run across Canada. Unfortunately, Terry was forced to abandon the marathon after completing 5,373 kilometers. His hopes of overcoming the disease and completing his marathon ended when he died nine months later.

A series of international fundraising runs have been held in his name every year. The Terry Fox Run is a volunteer organised event with 100% of funds raised donated to cancer research projects.

At ASHK, all students have just started their Healthy Bodies Unit in their PE classes. They will be discussing health-related fitness, nutrition, physical activity, and healthy minds! Your family joining us in the Terry Fox Run will support our unit goals by showing the importance of being physically active and involved in the

community. This year, if you join, the first 50 students can receive an ASHK Sports Towel!
