- PSAT testing was yesterday
- College applications teacher referrals, etc. November 1 deadline
- If 1 ref. letter is required & 1 recommended- should they just send 1- just typically send what is asked and no more, but it is up to you- check admissions website at each college and go from what that says
- Teacher recommendations- when do juniors ask for teacher recommendations- student doesn't see the letter- college wants it that way- submit everything in by June 1st- it is more to a specific date not how many a teacher will send- each teacher is different-toward the end of spring is when to ask the teachers for their letters- need to be presenting their good character, academic behavior, act appropriate- ask those teachers that will be able to paint a positive picture of you- start asking in March, but prepare with your attitude from day 1- do not ask past the deadline- need forms by a certain date
- Forms available on naviance- LONG forms for students and parents- keep in mind that these letters are a part of the larger picture you and what you send to the colleges- what did you do in my class that helps me paint a positive picture for you- those teachers you ask should be the teachers that know you well, really like you, what skills did you demonstrate in that class to show that you are great
- Is there a PA Higher education scholarship- yes see Trish Vaughn
- Do you have to fill out the fafsa form- everyone should really fill that out even if you don't need financial aid- everyone is at least available for a loan- depends on the school
- Juniors- process around seeing the college visits here- 100-150 colleges come to ur school every year- students get a list- student gets a pass from the teacher to go see the college representative- it is up to the specific teacher to let them skip class to go see the college- colleges keep track of your interest- there is no limit of how many you visit, but up to teacher if you can go or not- webinars happen as well when a school representative is not available to physically go to UHS
- Financial aid tonight- expert coming tonight to the meeting- talks about scholarships, differences between grants and loans
- What percentage of students here get scholarships?- counselors rely on the students to tell them, but counselors do not keep track or who does or doesn't get the scholarships
- Look to each school to see which scholarships that apply to that specific school- then you know what to apply for at UHS- always check the scholarship specific to each college
- UHS gave out \$60,000+ scholarships last year (not including the ROTC scholarships)
- Start writing those essays- so many scholarships to SO many things that we are not aware of. RESEARCH
