



International College (IC) in Lebanon is one of the largest international schools in the world. With over 3,600 students, the school has evolved throughout its long and rich history, dating back to 1891 in south-west Turkey, to an excellent institution, and one in a truly unique setting in the Middle East region and globally. The highest standards of academic and extra-curricular educational

opportunities are consistently adhered to, in line with international accreditations and authorizations, such as with the Council of International Schools (CIS), New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC), Agency for French Education Abroad (AEFE) and International Baccalaureate (IB). Chartered in the State of Massachusetts, US, and abiding by the laws of the Lebanese government, IC

remains a nonprofit organization, and one that is proudly independent and non-sectarian. Indeed, IC's many notable alumni across the world highlight the school's success, and, as they often remark, it is what the school offered them as a base for their life journey and career achievements, all encapsulated in the 'IC Spirit' both during their school days and right up to the present day.

Curricular Tracks

The Secondary School includes grades 10-12

The Lebanese Baccalaureate Program is a rigorous national program offered in either English or French with tracks that include General Sciences, Life Sciences, and Economics and Sociology. At the end of grade 12, all students are assessed by comprehensive exams set by the Lebanese Ministry of Education.

The College Preparatory Program is a three-year course modeled on a traditional high school program. The language of instruction is English. Required courses include Math, Sciences, English, Social Studies, and French with Arabic language at varying levels.

The French Baccalaureate Program is a demanding pre-university program of study established by the French Ministry of Education.

Students must choose a specialized program of study (les 3 séries or groups of subjects) within a core curriculum. The diploma is obtained at the end of grade 12, after externally assessed examinations are taken, and is the essential credential for entry into any university worldwide.

The International Baccalaureate Program (IBDP) is a demanding two-year curriculum with a rigorous assessment. It is made of six subject groups and a core comprising of theory of knowledge, creativity, activity, and service (CAS), and an extended essay. Through the core, students reflect on the nature of knowledge, complete independent research and undertake a project that often involves community service.

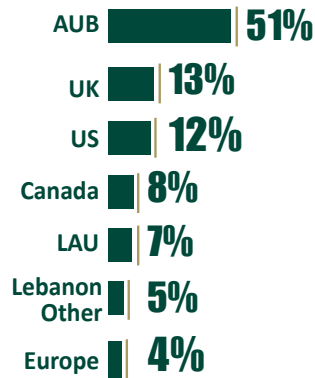
