Job Description Alumni Class Representative

Position Overview

At Southridge, we value our connection with alumni. No matter where you live, we are committed to providing opportunities for alumni to keep connected to the Southridge community and to each other. We accomplish this through communication, events and activities, all in partnership with our alumni association.

To help keep the alumni spirit strong, we are seeking volunteers for the position of *Alumni Class Representative*. As an *Alumni Class Representative*, you will help promote events and initiatives of the Alumni Association, and when it comes time, organize your class reunion. You will serve as an ambassador to help strengthen communication and connection between the school and our alumni community.

We are currently seeking 2-3 volunteers to represent each grad class. Please review the responsibilities, benefits and time commitment outlined below. To apply for this position, please submit an expression of interest to <u>alumniassociation@southridge.bc.ca</u>. All expressions of interest will be reviewed by the Alumni Executive Board.

We appreciate your interest and look forward to working with you to develop strong alumni connections with your grad class.

Key Responsibilities

- Act as a liaison between your grad class and the school, striving to keep your class connected
- Assist in alumni event promotion and class outreach
- Serve as 'the gatherer' of class news for the alumni e-newsletter, (ex: University graduation, marriage, birth of a child, a promotion or other accomplishments)
- Encourage alumni to submit their current contact information to the Alumni Relations office via the website or by email
- Brainstorm and implement ways for alumni to be more involved and stay connected
- Organize and promote class reunion events (with support from alumni relations office)
- Attend alumni events throughout the year (Christmas Reunion, Spring Social, Alumni Association Annual General Meeting, etc.)
- Distribute electronic survey following class reunion
- Provide feedback to the alumni relations office after events

Benefits

- Connections with the Southridge community including fellow grads
- Be the first to know about alumni events, news, and volunteer opportunities
- Social and intellectual enrichment
- Expand your networks for professional growth and development
- Opportunity to develop and promote skills sought by employers
- Continued involvement in the welfare and future of Southridge school
- Opportunity to exercise leadership and initiate change
- Opportunity to voice the opinions, concerns and ideas of your classmates so that they may be addressed
- Recognition at your alumni reunion
- Opportunity to see what the alumni association is all about before deciding to get more involved

Reporting structure

• Class Representatives' work is coordinated and supported by the Southridge Alumni Relations Office and the Alumni Association.

Time Commitment

New Class reps are encouraged to participate for a 1-year term, at which time they can decide if they want to continue on to serve a full 2+ year term. Participants may wish to increase their involvement with the alumni association and move to a more active role on the Alumni Association Board should a position become available, or simply continue on as a class representative. There are no term limits. This is not an elected position, but is assigned by the Alumni Executive Board following application. Class reps who wish to step down prior to finishing a term may do so in writing by contacting the alumni office.

On average, we estimate each class rep will invest 8 - 20 total hours throughout the school year (Sept – June). For reps organizing a class reunion, we estimate an additional 2- 6 hours.

- Contacting classmates: 2 6 hours (varies with class size and number of Class Reps).
- Organizing class-specific event (ie: class reunion): 2 6 hours.
- Gathering and sharing information (updating alumni contact info, gathering newsletter content, etc.): 2-4 hours.
- Preparing/submitting feedback and updates: 2 4 hours.
- Participating in the Alumni Executive Board meetings/year-end planning session: 2 16 hours (optional – hours will depend on how many meetings you choose to participate in)

Resources

In partnership with the Alumni Association, the Alumni Relations office will provide each Class Representative with a package including:

- Class contact list and privacy guidelines (in many cases there will be some missing contact information which the class rep will need to try and obtain through their own research)
- Sample emails and event flyers to help prepare the class-specific announcement/event
- Past reunion program
- A list of electronic resources to help former classmates contact one another
- A survey to submit feedback after the reunion is complete
- Templates to help craft class communications
