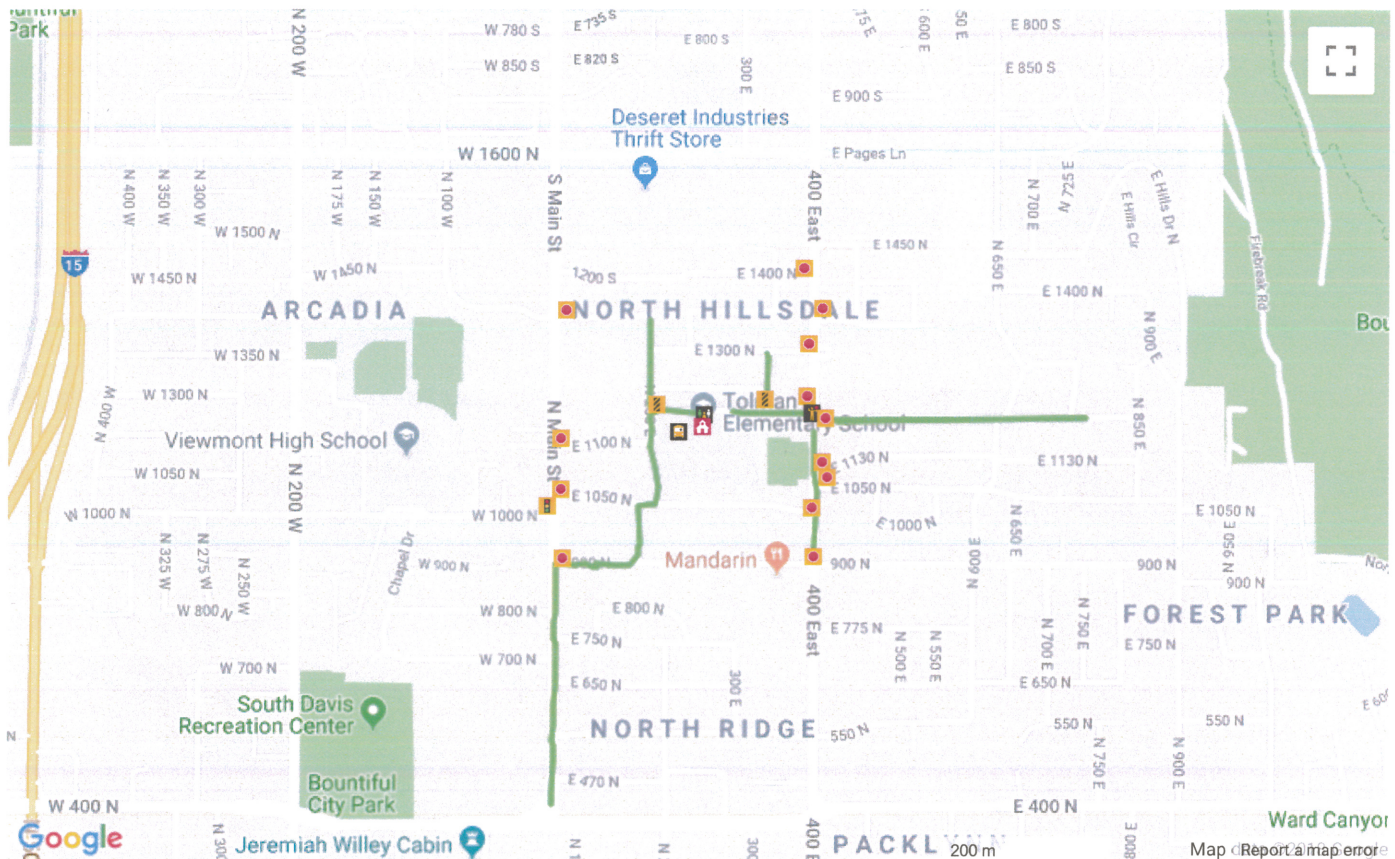

Tolman Elementary Student Neighborhood Access Plan 2018-19

1. School Location Tolman Elementary, 300 East. 1200 North, Bountiful, Utah 84010
2. Existing Traffic Controls Flashing lights for school crossing on 400 East
3. Established School Crossings 400 East 1200 North with a crossing guard
4. Present Access routes/with number of students using them
 - Area 1: Students above 400 East (east) from Pages Lane to 650 North to 900 North (north to south) should cross at the crossing guard at 1200 North and 400 East. Approximately 250 students
 - Area 2: Students below 400 East to Main Street (west), and from Pages Lane to 400 North. These students use 325 East, 200 East, 250 East, 170 East, 400 East, 1200 North, 1100 North and Main Street. Approximately 150 students.
5. Sidewalks or lack of East of 400 East there are very few sidewalks, except for 900 North. 90% of the area does not have sidewalks
6. Hazards (man-made and natural): Students need to use the crossing guard and shouldn't use short cuts to get home in crossing 400 East.
7. Bicycle routes: None
8. Future Growth Areas: There are a few growth areas from 1200 North to Pages Lane and above 900 East. In the past few years this has not affected the school significantly.
9. Loading or unloading by bus and other

transportation: The Learning Center/ Special Education has two (2) buses that use the bus loop on the west side of the school. Parents are encouraged to use the drop area at the front of the school, as outlined in the school plan. 10. Dissemination of Plan and Training: Parents have been notified in PTA meetings, Community Council, newsletter and school website. Spot patrols are done by the principal. Concerns: 1. Encourage placements of sidewalks so students do not have to walk in the road at the following locations: 1050 North, 1130 North and 1200 North east of 400 East. 2. Posted speed sign on 200 East and 1050 North off of Main Street. This will slow down the traffic to insure safety of children coming to and leaving from school. 3. Stop signs/slow signs/yield on the corner of 1200 North and 200 East coming from the east. This would slow down traffic and stop traffic to insure the safety of students crossing on 250 East. 1. We need a crosswalk painted on 175 East across 1050 North then across 200 East at 1050 North and at 1100 North across 200 East. These will not only provide direction for the students to cross, but will aid in awareness of safety. 1. Encourage the students to always use the crossing guard on 1200 North and 400 East. Students are encouraged on a daily basis to leave school grounds before the crossing guard leaves. Tolman Staff supports students by not keeping them after school. Students are also encouraged to walk home in groups and to contact parents by phone when necessary. Please drop your studnets off closer to 8:45 in the morning. Thank you
