NOTES:

Column **A** RegEd Capacity in the building (not counting portables) less rooms for SpEd

Column **B** Adjusted Capacity by State Rule, is 90% of **A** or **A** - 40, whichever is larger

Column **C** Projected RegEd enrollment for next school year

This is the initial estimate which is revised in February prior to allocation of staffing

Column **D** Open Capacity as defined in Davis Policy 5S-001-2, if **C** < **B** (priority to in-district students)

Column **E** If **C** > **B** (CLOSED) - then 1.5 % of **C** (priority to in-district students)

* The principal MAY accept up to this amount - Principal's Discretion

The purpose of the 1.5% variance is to permit some choice in all schools

even if the school is closed under State Rule

If **E** were greater than **D** for OPEN schools - **E** would be used
