## 3. School Improvement plan:

- a. Reviewed our 4 goals
  - i. Goal 1 – 70% of K-6 students will achieve 70% or higher on grade-level strand common formative and/or summative math assessments.
  - ii. Goal 2 – 70% of K-6 students will show growth from beginning-of-year formative writing benchmark to end-of-year benchmark in the area of informative/explanatory writing. Students will show .5 growth on 3-point writing rubric.
  - iii. Goal 3 – Adelaide elementary will participate in a school-wide CMI framework professional development to increase teacher confidence and understanding of elementary mathematics and the teaching and learning cycle. The goal will be achieved throughout the 2018-19 school year.
  - iv. Goal 4 – 70% of K-6 students will show typical or higher progress on DIBELS Pathways to Progress as measured by end-of-year DIBELS benchmark scores. K-6 students will increase 4% in DIBELS composite score proficiency from BOY to EOY
