









Township Municipal Population Growth




Local-County-State Comparative Population




Haverford: Population by Age Group: 1990 to 2010

Calendar Year Births







School Year Births-Sept-Aug














SDHT Enrollment 2000-17








Township District-wide Enrollment Projections






During the 2018-22 Projection period, the District will grow by 444 students or an average of 89 students per year.





Township Elementary K-Gr 5 Enrollment Projections








High School Grade 9-12 Enrollments



Chatham Park ES Enrollment by Year





Chestnutwold ES Enrollment by Year





Coopertown ES Enrollment by Year





Lynnewood ES Enrollment by Year





Manoa ES Enrollment by Year






Comparative Enrollments: Elementary Schools










Township 5-Year Enrollment Projections Summary

5-Year Projected

- **District** Steadily increases by 444 students by 2021
- K- Gr 5 Decreases 32 students by 2021
- **Gr 6-8** Increases by 215 students by 2021
- **Gr 9-12** Increases by 154 students by 2021





5-Year Enrollment Projections Elementary Summary

5-Year Projected

Chatham Park	Increases by 14 students to a 2021 high of 633 students
Chestnutwold	Decreases 7 students to a 2022 low of 578 students
Coopertown	Increases 10 students to 515 in 2022, after peaking at 525 in 2019
Lynnewood	Decreases by 2 students to 565 in 2022, after peaking at 577 in 2019
Manoa	Decreases by 36 students to 643 in 2022
