## **Long-Range District Planning Update Board of Education Workshop**

### **Introductions and Opening Thoughts**

Superintendent Dr. David Moyer introduced the workshop presenters: Brad Paulson, Terry Moeller and Craig Seipka from Wight & Company architects, Terry Fielding from International Contractors Inc. (ICI), communications consultant Marcia Sutter and Lesley Rogers of Strategies 360.

In July, the Board was presented with a draft Operational Plan, along with an abstract summarizing the big ideas included in the plan. "We have been waiting to approve the final plan because we needed to do work to flesh out the facilities concepts that emerged from the Focus 205 process and solicit additional community input and feedback on those concepts," said Dr. Moyer.

"Today, we will summarize the work that has been done to this point, share the initial facilities work to reflect the findings from Phase I of Focus 205, provide for interactive dialogue that will help further refine the concepts shared this morning, answer questions, and share some thoughts about next steps.

"We are not asking for approval of any final plan. Our goal is to share this information at the February 13 regular Board of Education meeting and receive authorization to move forward with a formal process of community engagement that will ultimately result in a Master Facilities Plan."
